Summary

In January 1999, the Baccalieu Trail Heritage Corperation undertook a project to record the heritage structures of the region, predating 1920 and those of unique architectural design or significance. Photographs of the buildings as well as Global Positioning System (GPS) readings were taken and architectural features were noted. Information relating to age, ownership, construction, alterations, etc. of these buildings was obtained from various sources throughout the community. Given the sources available during this time, there may be errors and/or omissions in these documents. Structures are listed in alphabetical order.

After the project was finished, each community was given a copy of their own respective inventory. At some point, the copy of the Heritage Structure Inventory of Carbonear went missing. As a result, the Carbonear Heritage Society hired Brandon Mullins to recreate the project using original data from the Baccalieu Trail Heritage Corporation during the summer of 2015. It is important to note that though this inventory was compiled in 2015, the information is current only as of 1999. All pictures are from 1999 unless otherwise noted.






