



Plaque Installation Guidelines

This plaque, which shall remain the property of Heritage NL (HNL) and which commemorates the designated property, is provided by HNL and must be displayed at a suitable location on the property. Plaques may be reissued from time to time in which case the former plaque must be returned.

This plaque should:

- be mounted with four stainless steel screws;
- be mounted within 10ft (3m) of, and with text facing, a public road or right-of-way;
- be mounted solidly on a structure, fence, or a signpost;
- be un-obscured by foliage, landscape features, or other structures; and
- not be mounted in direct sunlight if possible.

If mounting on clapboard care should be taken not to screw too close to the end of a board which may result in splitting. For a four-inch course HNL recommends mounting the plaque approximately 1-1/8" from the bottom edge of the lower clapboard (see diagram).
